The University of Western Australia Cricket Club (**UWACC**) is committed to maintaining the highest standards of behavior and conduct amongst its members and stakeholders. In the event of a breach of the UWACC Code of Conduct to a level warranting referral to the WACA Tribunal, this Tribunal Policy will come into effect.

Purpose

The purpose of this WACA Tribunal Policy is to protect the UWACC from the risks associated with player conduct warranting referral to the WACA Tribunal managing issues subsequently arising as a result of that relevant conduct.

Reportable Offence

The UWACC does not condone behaviour constituting a reportable offence by any player in any circumstance. Such behaviour damages the UWACC, is a breach of the UWACC Code of Conduct and will be treated as such. In the event of a report of a player by a match official, the following procedure is to be followed:

| Notify | The Head Coach and President are to be notified of the report and any relevant details as soon as practicable. |
| Discuss | As appropriate, relevant members of the UWACC Committee, coaching staff, captaincy group and playing list will confer to discuss the events leading up to the report, whether to appeal the report and any further disciplinary action to be taken if necessary. By behaving in a manner warranting report and therefore causing damage to the UWACC, the player forfeits their independent right to appeal. Appeals may only be lodged with the approval of the UWACC Committee. |
| Act | Pending the outcome of discussion as outlined above, the appropriate action will be taken and communicated to the reported player in question. |
